

## Recommendations for your visit

The Ralli Museum boasts large exhibition spaces, comprising ten rooms across two floors. These rooms are divided into temporary exhibitions and the permanent collection, where we find several rooms with a specific theme. This is the best way to bring Latin American art to visitors.

Due to the dimensions of the Museum and the variety of works it houses, we recommend setting aside at least an hour to enjoy your visit.\*

The Ralli Museum is a non-profit museum which offers free entrance. The space invites you to enjoy the works and their surroundings alike. Visitors are permitted to take photos without flash, videos, take notes, etc. The Museum offers rest areas\*\* and invites you to spend as long as you wish here, respecting the space and the other visitors.



The Museum's facilities are adapted to accessibility regulations, with ramps in the rooms and a lift.

## Groups

Although we do not offer guided visits, the Museum can provide teaching materials to schools' educators if ordered in advance. We recommend you contact the Museum beforehand to help organise your visit.

## **Cloakroom**

For your comfort and to protect the works of art, we offer a **free cloakroom service**.

## **Rules**

The works of art are unique, valuable objects that we must preserve for future generations. It is therefore **prohibited to touch any of the works**. Please **respect the safety distances and signs in each room**.

**It is not permitted to enter with umbrellas or sharp objects, backpacks, bags or suitcases larger than 35 x 40 cm.**

**The use of mobile phones for calls or audio messages is not permitted in the rooms.** Please respect the space and other visitors, and avoid speaking loudly.

**It is not permitted to enter with food, juice or soft drinks.**

For your safety and to protect the works of art, **running in the Museum is prohibited**.

If you are accompanied by minors, keep them by your side at all times and ensure they behave correctly.
